

Alice of Namur

Alice of Namur (died July 1169 at Valenciennes) was the daughter of Godfrey I, Count of Namur and Ermesinde the daughter of Conrad I of Luxembourg.^[1]

Her father married her off to Baldwin IV, Count of Hainaut around 1130.^[2] Gislebert of Mons described her as having "a graceful body and a beautiful face".^[3] Her son was the heir of Namur when her brother Henry IV of Luxembourg died childless in 1196.

Her children with Baldwin IV of Hainaut were:

- Yolande (1131/5 – after 1202), wife of Ives II, Count of Soissons, and Hugh IV, Count of St Pol^[4]
- Baldwin (1134 – 1147/50)^[5]
- Agnes (1140/45 – 1174 or after), married Raoul de Coucy^[4]
- Geoffrey, Count of Oostrevant (1147–1163), first husband of Eleanor, Countess of Vermandois^[5]
- Laurretta (died 1181), wife of Thierry of Alost (Dirk van Aalst) and Bouchard IV, Sire of Montmorency^[4]
- Baldwin V, Count of Hainaut (1150–1195), later Count of Flanders by marriage to Margaret I of Flanders^[5]
- Henry (died after 1207), Seigneur of Sebourg^[5]
- Bertha^[6]

She was buried inside Saint Waltrude Collegiate Church.^[7]
