Belinda Tracy of Bowdoin and William Cornish of Lisbon, m. 7 Feb 1841, Belinda having been b. 2 Aug 1820. Mr. Moses Tracy of Lisbon and Miss Ruth Hall of Bowdoin, m. int. Lisbon 26 Aug 1826 (another rec 4 Oct 1826). It appears that this couple did not marry.

ADAM TRUFANT (Samuel, Job) - farmer, 48, House #50 in 1850 Census, b. 22 Apr 1802; m. (1) Marium (sp on stone - maiden name unknown), who d. 1 May 1845 at 45y; bur. South Cem. He m. (2) Elizabeth (maiden name unknown), b. ab 1798, ME (52 in C.). He d. 4 Oct 1855 at 54y; bur. South Cem. Children:

1. William B., b. 3 Aug 1830, ME (21 in C. - laborer); m. Margaret A. (maiden name unknown).
2. Phebe, b. 1 Aug 1834 (16 in C.), b. ME; m. she of Topsham Zacheus McClellan Beal, 3 Oct 1854, he elder of Calvinist Baptist Church, Bowdoinham. In 1850 Census, Adam's father Samuel, liv with Samuel and was 71, a laborer.

WILLIAM B. TRUFANT (Adam, Samuel, Job) - Civil War corporal, b. 3 Aug 1830, Bowdoin; m. Margaret A. (maiden name unknown), b. 1836; d. 10 May 1920 at 83y 5m 21d; bur. South Cem. He d. 3 Jun 1905 at 74y 10m; bur. South Cem.
