my name is Hubert Thomas Wright I was born December 2 3 1 9 0 6 I was born at Yeaden Yorkshire England I came to this country in 1 9 1 1 with my mother and brother an with my mother and brother William as my father was already over here he came over here a few months earler .We left Liverpool England Not on the ship we were to come on as at that time they had a long PtcKSTI dodkthership called the Haverford was the ship we were to come but do to the strike they could not unload or instead of the Haverford we had to get on a ship called the Celtic On the first ship we were to get on was to go on was to go to Phila. and m_Y fater was to meet us but the second ship whent to N, Y, so m_{Y} father and another $m_{\alpha n}$ had to go to N.Y, and get us WE wereat Elise Island My mother told me that the ship we were on was over loaded and below the safe water line . So while we were at sea the the captain told the men to throw over board all the heavey cargo over over the side so as to lighten the load and make it safe Mom said we got all the fruit we could eat as they had a lot of oranges and were throwing the over the side We were in Steeage thats near the bottom of the ship stacked in like catle . My mother had a hard time getting milk for my brother Bill as he was a baby so she told the woman in charge that if she did not get her some milk for her baby she would see the captain .My mother was a fighter and could back it up too so it was not long befor she got the milk and plenty of it and gave some to the other mothers too well we got to Elice Island .I think it took us 1 1 days to get there We were behind bars looking out .for my father .My mother said that I saw him and yelled dady dady and he saw us and camed over and got us out he and the man that was with jim , they Took us to Phila, to some people called Bell .they lived on a street caled Larence St, we lived there for awhile I rememberd that there was a Textile Mill there.Latter we moved to a house near by lalled Liffgo St We were only there a short time as my father worked in a mill at D, and ontario so they got a house on a street caled Harville St, we lived there quite awhile . My sister was born there Her name was Annie like my mothers

We seemed to be happy there as we lived there till 1 9 16 then my aunt talked them into comming to Marcus Hook Told them of the good jobs there was there. My father got a job at the Chester Co. 1 there was there .My father got a job at the Chester Ship Yard as it payed more money We lived with my aunt for awhile .We went to the Italion Church when it first started .I was an alter boy there . Later we and Bill Morris and his family moved to Lindwood as my mother did no get along too well with my aunt Norra it was on Harvey Ave Me and my brother Bill went to the Holy Saver Catholic church then We were there for a short time when my father and Bill Morris got a Brsinstorm to build there own house in Lennix Park .at that time it was it was a let down as my father was out of work as the Ship Yard shut down and my mother had to go to work at the viscos Thiswas about 1920 Me and my brother Bill went to the Resurecinn School then . We finealy got the house built after a lot of hard work and Heart Breaks but we made My other kinfolks built homes too u p there I was about 14 when i got a job in a box factory On Jeffery St in Che er at 7,50 a week I worked there for while then my father got me a job in a furniture factory in Chester It payed 12.50 a week that was better Later I got a job in another Furniture Factory I made about 17.50 a week there I worked there for awhile Then I saw an ad in the papper for a carpenters helper .As I wanted to to be a carpenter ai took the job I liked the job as it payed the same but I only had to work 8 Hours a day as to the otheres I had to work 12 hr I worked for a man called Bill Getty who lived in Chester I worked for about 4 Kyears then the building whent bust and I was out of work I picked a few odd jobs but not too steady .S o my cousins husbands got me a job at the Sinclair Oil co, I worked there for about 45 years till I rMtiBedther Thomas was born in Lennox Park in the 2 o s He grew up and work at the Viscos till he joind the Marins at the star of the World War 2 in 1941 he was about 18 years old then In May 5 1942 I was drafted in the Army I was sent to Ft, Meade for a few days then to Ft, Bragg N,C for about 1 3 weeks for Basice training . Then to Cal, to Ft, Cronkite After a few months there we whent to Grays Harbor in Wash State I was there about a year then we were shiped over seas we whent to Oahu Hawaii for more training After a few months we were shiped out again To the Marshells then to the Palau Islands on a little Island called angar ment to Record the Island that my brother Tom was on .This is where he Lost his It was about a month befor I found out about it when eyes in battle a letter from my mother and she told me about it Our next stop was Cbeu in the South of the Philipens I was there till the end of the war Then we shipped out for home It took 15 days Going over we lost Sunday comming we had 2 Wed, We landed at the Navy /ARD

We came in through the inland water ways of the State o Wash, We came in the State o Wash, it was just breaking daylight when we saw land it was a beautiful it was just breaking the site for us all it was for me as I had not seen it was a beautiful site for us all sat down and cried In awhite site for us all 10 half years , We all sat down and cried In awhile they came out to to greet us with sighns saying Welcome Home Blowing there horns and whistles all the way in to the Navy yard at Bremerton Wash, We unloaded our things and then got into the army trucks to take us a Baracks there we were shown were we were to sleep that night Then we went to a large mess hall for our supper .It was the larges ? One I had ever seen and I had ween a lot of them large and small .And we sure did eat .We were waited on by Germman Prisoners and even they welcomed us home .After that we went to our place where to sleep for the night .It was not long befor we were all asleep The next morning we were sorted out as to where we came from As I was from Phila. I was in that group After awhile the Oficer called us out and said the first group gos on the first flight the second on the next That was the one I was on At first I did not know what they ment But I found out that I was going g to fly home This was the first time that I had ever folwn but it did not bother me as now I was headed for home sweet home They took us to the airport at Seatattle Wash There we got on the plane 2 4 of us . It took us 15 hours and 5 stops to get to Newark N J, When we got off the plane we got on the truck and they touck us to the r r station The oficer in charge told us to go to the resurant and get what ever we wanted and we did just that and to stay right there till he got back . He was in a little while then we got on the train We all had seats in the same car Then we whent to Harrisburg P A There they picked usup with trucks and took us to Indian town gap P A Well this was a riot as it was the worst place I was ever at The building was a mess and dirty . The bunks were lined up along the wall it had teo stoves one at each end .A guy was in bed when we got there he was at the other end .He was a sarge nt .When we got in he came up to us and started to pop off .Well we let him go on

fill he ran out of steam then we told him to shut up and give his ass a chance .One look at us and he went back to wis bunk and left us alone stove we got some wood and coal and got the other stove going as it was We got some wood and coal was cold up there .After awhile we went to bed we got up early the next morning .He showed us where to Laterein was We got up early
We got shaved and showerd then he took us to the mess hallfor breakfast .Well that was a little better not much .After that an oficer came an and took us to a hall .they gave us us what they called a I cant rember it now and took us to a mark. They had a bunch ot head shrinkers. They asked us a lot of silly Like when was the last time you were out with a woman and if you got go out with one what will you do and all that stuff .Well when they got the answers and got done with us they were ready to clinb the walls Then they told us that we hadto be polite when we were eating how to ask for more bread or butter . Not to say pass the Damm butter or or pass the Dam bread but we had say Please pass the Damm bread or please pass theDammbutter and all that stuff Well after we had ginner we had to go to to a building to get rid of our things that they said we had to turn in and keep the rest witch was not much . After that we had to change our money from Pesos to u s monet as thats what we had that is most of usdidd Then we had to go to the pay window to get our pay that was decree due us We got one hundred dollars and out train tickets to Phila, as we would get the rest in three monthly pay ments thats how we got payed as we had a lot of back pay due us as when we were over seas we only got part pay .Then they told us why we only got 100 dollars to go out with ,It seems that the first ones were payed in full and when they got to town they got roolded and were left brok and had to go to the M \bar{e} s for help to get home so thats why we only got 100 dollars and our tickets They did send it to me in momthly payments I ws with a fellow that was in my out fit He was from Virginia Beach but his wife was in Green Ridge that was just out side Chester as you remember So we went together We got off at north Phila, Station then got the train to Chester as from there on I knew the way home . We got off the train in Chester and he called his wife and told her he was at the station Thats the last I saw of him I went up to 7th Street and was out side the movies , Then I called M home to tell them where I was In a short time my brother bill and tom and my father were there to pick me up it was a grand feeling They got me home and the house was full .My mother liked to eat me up she she was so glad to see me so were the others too It was some night And I was so glad to be home again After awhile they gave me some thing to eat . Then we all talked for awhile My brother Tom and his wife left and so did the others too By the way Tom had got married to the nurse that touch care of him in the They were now living phila, Navy hospital . She was from Concord N H in Mc Cafity Village for awhile then they moved to Concord latteron Well after awhile we all went to bed as the rest had all gone home So we all had a good nights sleep as mother was very happy now

we wre all home .My brother was devorst from his wife Barbara That is Bill I am talking about .So the next morning my mother told me to to go to the Ration board and get my stamps .So I took the car and went to go to the Kation ... to Grant to Chester to the Masonic building and saw the lady there and told her what I wanted and she got out the book ,Then started to take ouy the thestamps .When she was finished all I had left was a few stamps and the two covers .I ask her why I did not get more and she told med that there had been a war on .I told her that I did not know as where I was we did get a Newspaper and left .I was i uniform too .When I got home and gave it to my mother and boy did she blow her top , She calld her every thing under the Sun I told mother the way you are swearing you of been in the army you would of made a First Sargent She got her coat on and we went to the Bucher stor I think the mans name was Harry We went in side and she showed him the book I got He knew me from away back so he ask mother what she wanted and she told him .And that she had to feed me too .So she told him what she wanted but did not have enough stamps He said forget it and filled up the bags . We tha nked him very much ,He said if she wanted mor to come back Well we talked for awhile then then we went home and had lunch . After that dwent down to the plant

and reported to the man in charge .He looked up my records and ask me when I was comeing back .I told him that I would be back the First week in Dec, ,He said that will be fine So I went back to work .I met most of the men I worked with also some new ones too They were glad to see me back and some others that had just came back tooSo the week went along fine till I found out that we had to work 6 days a week as the Nevy had taken over the Plant This lasted till the end of Dec,, Then it went back to to Sinclair again then we worked 5 days .I was told of how when the Navy had it they could work as long as they liked and they did . They sure made a lot of money too all the over time the wanted to work It was now getting into Mar,. Now they put up the list for vacations As I had a lot of time in I was near the top .As i was looking over the list Ar. Irish man came over to me and said that I should be on that list NOT

as I was away too long he was some kind of a cleark in yhe office I told him that I was gooing to take off 2 weeks in Aug, He said that I could not do that as i would foul up the others Later on I saw the big boss and told him what I wanted and he took me by the collor and look at the sheets and tell what I wanted I told him that Mac, had told me and he said that he was full of crap as I had that Mac, had could take any ones I want .He was a wwl vet and I knew him a long time my father had worked for him in the Shipyard

Later on they had a a Banquet for us Vets that just came home they had it in St Hedwicks Hall in Chester, We had a good time as of us there .I did not know that there had been so many in the sevice they had came in the plant later on when they were hireing more men hire mor men to take our places Well this is about all I got for now. Well here it is the rest of my life story I will call it the love life . So I will start out with my first girl frend . She was the neice of Maggie Morris. The first wife of Bill Morris my cousin. She was born in Ireland .County Mayo Bill Morris my coustr.

Came over here when she was a little girl .She lived in W Phila I met her at my uncles Vewing He was Bill Morris father .His name mhats were I got my name from .She was 2 was Hubert .Thats were I got my name from .She was about my age 2 1 She lived with her mother brother and three sisters as her father was away from home almost all the time .He was what we call a roaver . Could not stay in one place too lomg. Allways on the run as we would say .He would come and stay long enough to get her mother in the family way then take off again .Come back after the the kids were born then take off again .. Leaveing Madge that was her name and her brother John to take care of the family . She worked for the A,T, and T. Telephone co, John worked in a outo repare shop .Later on got in his own shop .then he got Married and left home ,Then it was up tp Madge to keep the family . There was her mother and three sisters to keep .So we can see she had her hands full as th girls were growing up Her mother never worked I dont think , She would tell Fortunes whith cards .. She seened to have a lot of customers too .Suckers we call them . They were all Irish English and Scots. They were great for it . My mother would tell me how in the old ones that had gone to the beyond and bring them back

country they had women that were Mediums .They could talk to the ones that had gone to the beyond and bring them back and you could talk to them .My mother could sure tell some wild tales about them ..Well I did like Madge but could not get too serious as could see what I would be getting into if I Marryed her so I was carful in away .

On garret Rd. It was some times an Irihs Dance other times it was what we called aCountry dance, It was run by a man called James . He had two places going for him, This one and one up in Exton caled Old Orcard I think , I was never up there as it was too far away for me to go to . I had some good times up there .I went there on my nights off from work. A lot of times on the week ends . Some times in the middle of the week too Someone told me about the Nixon Ballroom . It was in W Phila On 52 nd St Between Market And Chestnut St .I liked it there as they all seemed so Sociable .I had a lot of good times there too.I met a lot of girls there too .And made a lot of freinds too .This was where I met Jean as she use to go there too on Saterday nights . She and I were real freindly . I know you you will not beleive this bout Jean was Short and fat Bout jolley We danced together a lot and talked too .But that was that for the time I met other girls and had dates too .But I met this other girl . Marurette Mc Ginnis .I found out that they were freinds and went to secol school together .So I started to date her .Her mother invited me for Sunday dinner and from there on I went there quite ofton . I took them out for aride on Sundays .I took them out to Markam Del Co, And to Ivey Mills this was where her mother was from her father was from GHen Mother had a brother that lived in Markham . He lived in what was the old R,R Station .This train ran from Lamoken in Chester to Oxford Pa The R R ran in back of there house .. It had been a long time since they had been there so they were happy to see the old place again. We went up there quite a few times later .I also met her cousen who lived i Weat Chester too .I took them up there a few times and they liked it We went to the shore quite afew times in the Summers and in the spring Well came W W 2 then I had to go away for Three and ahalf Years. I came back in November of 45 . She seemed to be glad to see me back. A year later I took her a ring and ask her to be my Wife . She said No she could not Marry me and that we should not see each other any more I dont know why but that was it and I never saw her again I wrote to her mother and tried to find out why but got no answer I learned later that Jean knew the anwer but she never told me. Well the next Saturday Bill said would I 14 like to take her step mother with us to the dance .I said why not .So the next Saturday night I went around and picked them up .I was surprised to see her. As I had danced with her up at the dance at Garret Road where they had the country dances . So in away I knew her from there . We realy had a good time So we went out the next Sat, nighjt.So I took them to ther house and stayed there awhile then Bill and I went home Bill had gave Jean our phone number Her step mother ask us to come up for Sunday dinner . So knowing me I never turned down a good meal so I said yes . We had a very nice dinner . She had Sweet ; potatoe all drest up .I told her later on that the way to amans heart was through his his stomach . After dinner Bill took Jean out and Emily that was her name and I went to the Movies . We got along good I was srprised as she looked very good We went home and talked for awhile then Bill and Jean came in Well we was now goining steady now . In the meantime I took her out to the movies and out to dinner too we both seaned very happy .By now Jean and Bill were very thick the queston to Emily and one sale less she had been a widow for over a year or so by now Jean and Bill likedit very much . So we made it for June . This was 19 49 Sill and Jean went to Maryland they Eloped .The lived there for awhile As bill said it was too far to go to work . As it was in the early Summer we got a very nice place . A room with bath near the beach .We had a very good time .We were there for over a week as I had two weeks vacation . In the meantime she had quit her job as I did not want her to work any more as I would be the breadwiner from then on After that the man that owned the house said he was going to sell the house . So we went out and looked for a place . We saw the sample house that was on the corner just agrost the street from where I now live As Emily realy liked the house we put the down payment on ii. . It was to be done in March But did not get finished till April . We moved in April 28 1950 . It was on a Friday and it was wet and rainy but we made it . As it was wet andraining we did not get a chance to look around the yard and out side . We went out to supper that night as we did not have too much food in . We were going to get some the next day so we did use the stove .It was Eletric .The next morning when Emily went to use the stove it did not work I went down the cellar to see what was the matter and I found out that they had not put in the fusses in for stove .So I wrote down the size and then we went out for breakfast . Then we went to Morton to a harware store to get the fusses . On the way over I started to kid her about how these country Towns took in there pavements at night and put them back in the morning. As we walked up the street Lo and behold there they were outing back the slabs of pacement . So I kept on going till I saw a sighn that said Rt 130 then I knew where I was as I had been on it afew times It took me to the feery and home .As I was in Chester I took Mom and Pop to there home Then came home to our house Well thats that for Maine . Her dauhter Emily had a baby in December so my Emily went up to see her as she had a boy . They called him John His fathers name was Paul . She went up by train . The Pennsy to N y Then on the n Y C to Albany They picked her up there . She was up there for a week . Then I went up for the weekend by train too as it was the best way at the time. So in the early Summer young Emily moved the Scheneetady N Y . They had bought a new home in a place called Freds Way up North of the city So late in the Summer Emily and I rode up.to see them. As useual I go lost on the way up as it was along trip . There was no N Y Thruway then as they were just started to build it . So when we reached Kingston N Y we had to take (.W to Arbany .We got there allwright Young Emily had drew us a map how to get there . It was a good one too. But my Emily was reading it I was just driveing . We were at the mouth of the Mohawk River so we were lost We should of been at the other end of the River up to the No th .I took the map and looked at it She had the map upside down and was giveing me the directions that way

It was a very nice one too . While it had been a large one at the time of WW 2 they only used a part of it now . We had a good Supper and felt a lot better now . After we ate we drove around a bit and saw the town or what was left of it as most of the stores were closed and out of busines: It looked like Chester is now, We had a good nights sleep as we were tired now .The next morning we realy ψf felt good now so we went and got our breakfast

Next mornknh we were on our way to the next town that was call led Garage Cayuga .It was on the lake by the same name ell it was a little better as there was a College there .so it was not quite so deserted .Wesaw the other lakes too then went home to young Emilys. We got there that night late but it was alright as we ate supper on the way there We talked that night and told them all about our trip. We left two days later .The trip back was nice till I got to out side of Norristown then I took the wrong road at Bridgeport .Instead of 3 2 o I got on another road .In awhile I saw the sighn that said to Chester so I knew where I was so we got home that night ,Not too late .About 9 3 0 Boy was we glad to get back home again as we had enough rideing for awhile We saw young Emily the next summer . Emily and Paul came down that time for a few days . You think your Grand Kids are bad . You should of seen them They were a mess .Into all the things they could get into.Nothing was good enough for them they were spoiled roton Drove my Emily up the Wall They were going to see his people in Norfolk V A . Then to a place called Nags head N C, I was glad to get rid of them I mean the Kids as we were glad to see young Emily Well as the years went by things got worse .First my father died of Canser in the throat in 5 6 then Bill bot sick had a Brain Tummer He was in the Crazier Hospital at the same time my mother got sick she had she was in at the same time This was in 6 8 Mother died Right after that Bill got real bad . She got a job at the hospital .Night shift 1 1 to 7 .In the meantime I was ready to retir .In december I was to retire But in October I got this Hernier I went to the first aid in the plant and showed the nurse the lum on my side in front left side .She said to wait for the plant doctor to see me He told me to see my own doctor .In the meantime the nurse told the plant that I was to retire in December .So he said you will not be back to work So I called up Jean to tell her as I knew she was not in bed yet

He told me that I had to get a operation and sent me to a Surgen up on Edgmont Av in Parkside I think So he called in and got me admited This is where Mairan cam in as she and Jean took me in as they told me to leave my car home and she would pick me up and take me to the hospital . They did so as Jean was off that day In the meantime the Nurse had gave me the forms to take in with me Well this is where she pulled her rank or something she told them that she wanted me on the 4 th floor of the new building as that was water where she worked This was Monday morning Well I got in alright . The next day they opoated . All my people came to see me Jean was off for a couple of nights so she told Martha her freind she was a colard L P N ,I told Jean that it Ment Little Polish Nurse She did take good care of me as Jean told her who I was In a few days I was out .Jean told me she got me sprung .Thats how they say when they get get you out of Jail . And Marian retird and as her son Grdon was still in the air force and was in Japan so she went there to see him for awhile 'Then he was sent to the States .I think to it was Shreveport L A so she went there to live with him Now this was the begining of Jeans air traveling and she liked it a lot She went by Delta air line . She would go to Atlanta and change for Shreveport where Mariam would pick her up and take her to her place. This was not the first time that Jean had been on on a plane as she and Marian had been to Las . Vagas with a group a few months befor Gordan had been sent to Dover DL, so she went to live with Gordan there She would come up to see us a few times and stay for a week Befor this my sister got very sick .as she could not get along with her dauter in law amd her kids as the young one was a bad one as her mother and my nehpew worked and she went wild bringing boys up to her bed room .My sister came to live with me so I took care of her for awhile Befor all this Jean got a dog a little white on she called Niki She got off the woman up stairs as they did not want it and they did not treet it too good so Jean took it ..At first it would try to bit me if I went wear it .But one night at the supper table she came to me and I gave it a bone and some meat after that I could not get rid of her .We were freinds from then on..
