

Jean Baptiste Hent aka Jean-Baptiste Jahan dit LaViolette and Therese Arcenaud from Sieur de la Roque 1752 Census for Ile Saint Jean: Malpec

“Jean Baptiste Hent, native of the Isle d'Orléans, parish of Saint-Jean, bishopric of Quebec, aged 19 years, he has only been one year in the country. Married to Thérèse Arcenaud, native of Macpec [Malpec], aged 20 years. The whole of their live stock consists of one heifer, three ewes, and three fowls.

They are settled on the land of Pierre Arcenaud, his wife's father.”
