\* Why was Thomas Evans included in this transaction? He m. at Freetown 15 June 1750 HANNAH HATHAWAY (*V/R* citing Rev. Silas Brett's marriages), but there is no clue to her parentage. She is not listed in the estate divisions of Isaac and Rebecca. She was not the same as Irana, whose parents are named in her death record.

**662. MARY WARREN**<sup>5</sup> (*Rebecca Church*<sup>4</sup>, *Caleb*<sup>3</sup>, *Elizabeth*<sup>2</sup> *Warren, Richard*<sup>1</sup>) was born at Watertown about 1703, and died at Marlboro, N.H., 1 June 1793.

She married\* at Watertown 3 April 1729 **BENJAMIN TUCKER**, who was born at Roxbury 15 March 1703/4 and died at Marlboro, N.H., 20 May 1785, son of Benjamin and Elizabeth (Williams) Tucker.

On 19 March 1765 Benjamin Tucker of Leicester, gentleman, sold land in Leicester to Edward Bond of Brimfield; wife Mary also signed.

On 23 September 1764 Joseph Biglo sold land in Monadnock No. 5 Township [later Marlboro, N.H.] to Benjamin Tucker of Leicester, gentleman.

On 23 March 1769 Benjamin Tucker of Monadnock No. 5, yeoman, sold land to Joshua Tucker of Monadnock No. 5, yeoman, and he sold land to Moses Tucker on 8 January 1771.

The inventory of the estate of Benjamin Tucker was taken 29 October 1786 and sworn to by Abijah Tucker, administrator, on 22 January 1787 when the widow's third was set off.

**663. ELIZABETH WARREN<sup>5</sup>** (*Rebecca Church<sup>4</sup>, Caleb<sup>3</sup>, Elizabeth<sup>2</sup> Warren, Richard<sup>1</sup>*) was born at Watertown 19 June 1704, and was living in 1764, when she wrote a letter to her son Peter.

She married at Watertown 19 May 1726 **PETER GIBBONS**, who died before 27 December 1729 when inventory of his estate was taken. He married first, at Boston 22 April 1725, Abigail Simpson.

On 1 January 1729 Elizabeth Gibbons, widow, of Boston, was appointed administratrix of the estate of her husband Peter Gibbons, late of Boston, joyner.

**664. ABIGAIL WARREN<sup>5</sup>** (*Rebecca Church<sup>4</sup>, Caleb<sup>3</sup>, Elizabeth<sup>2</sup> Warren, Richard<sup>1</sup>*) was born at Watertown 20 December 1705.

She married at Westboro 10 June 1729 **JEDEDIAH HOW**, who was born at Marlborough 3 April 1701 and died before 22 September 1761, son of Joseph and Dorothy (Marton) How.

On 22 September 1761 Jedediah How of Brookfield posted bond as administrator of the estate of his late father Jedediah How late of New Braintree, yeoman.

On 13 April 1763 the land was assigned to sons Jedediah How, Elijah How, Silas How, and Jonah How provided they make payments to their brother Solomon, sister Dorothy, and sister Abigail Gould.
