12. SIR WILLIAM CONSTABLE, KNT., 5th son, d. 1528, of Caythorpe and Wassand, co. York; m. Joan Fullthorpe, will pr. 18 Dec. 1540, dau. of Thomas Fullthorpe, d. 1468, of Rudstan, co. York.

13. MARMADUKE CONSTABLE, ESQ., of Wassand in Holderness, co. York, d. 1558; m. Elizabeth Stokes, d. 1560, bur. at Goxhill, dau. of Robert Stokes, of Goxhill and Bycherton, co. York, by Bridget (Carleton?), d. 1556, widow of Sir William Gascoigne. (*Visitations of Yorkshire*, 298).

14. MARMADUKE CONSTABLE, of Wassand, bur. Goxhill, 11 July 1568, will pr. same month; m. Catherine, will dtd. 1628, bur. 9 June 1634, ae. 90 yrs., dau. of John Holme, of Paull Holme, co. York.

15. WILLIAM CONSTABLE, GENT., of Drax Abbey, co. York, 1613, d. 1618; name of wife not known.

16. THE REV. MARMADUKE CONSTABLE, A.M., b. 1593/4, d. Everingham, co. York, 18 Aug. 1638; A.B., Queens Coll., Camb., 1614/5, A.M., 1618, Rector of Newton-by-Tofte, co. Lincoln, 1618, and of Everingham, co. York, 1618–1638; m. Everingham, 17 May 1632, Katherine Elithorpe, prob. b. at Holme-on-Spalding-Moor, co. York, d. Wallingford, Connecticut, 27 Jan. 1687/8; she m. (2) c. 1641/2, Deacon Richard Miles of Milford and New Haven, Conn. (by whom she had 3 children).

17. GEORGE CONSTABLE, bp. 23 Dec. 1635, took oath of fidelity at New Haven, Conn., 7 Apr. 1657, but returned to England. He had two elder brothers: **WILLIAM**, bp. 3 June 1633, and **MARMADUKE**, bp. 28 Aug. 1634, of whom one is supposed to have d.y., and the other to have returned to England. 13. SIR WILLIAM CALVERLEY, KNT. (87-13), d. 1488; m. 1441, Agnes Tempest.

14. ELIZABETH CALVERLEY; m. Thomas Wentworth, of North Elmsall, son of Sir John Wentworth, of North Elmsall, co. York, and Jane, dau. of Richard Beaumont. (Generations 13 to 18: *Lincolnshire Pedigrees*, pp. 1062–1063; *Wentworth Genealogy*, I 55-63; *Marbury Ancestry*, p. 25; William Flower, *Visitations of Yorkshire*, 1563–1564).

15. THOMAS WENTWORTH, of North Elmsall, in the Parish of Kirkby, co. York, will dated 1522/3; m. Jane, dau. of Oliver Mirfield, of Howley, co. York, by Isabel Eland. (Michael Stead, *Records of the Parish of Batley*, p. 274). Thomas Wentworth of Elmsall and Sir William Mirfield were appointed administrators of the estate of Isabel (Eland) (Mirfield) Ayshton, 22 Nov. 1488 (Stead, p. 300). This confirms the marriage of Thomas (d. 1523) and Jane, only sister and heir of Sir William who d.s.p. After his death the Mirfield estates went to the heirs of Thomas and Jane. Sir Thomas Wentworth is given by Stead (*Records of Batley*, p. 134) as the husband of Jane, dau. of Oliver Mirfield, which is undoubtedly correct.

St. Peter-at-Gowts, Lincoln, co. Lincoln, 19 Aug. 1583, **KATHERINE MARBURY** (78A-15). (Meredith B. Colket, Jr., *Marbury Ancestry*, p. 25; *Wentworth Genealogy*, 60-63).

19. **ANNE WENTWORTH**, bp. Irby-on-Humber, 28 Oct. 1585, living 1628; m. the Rev. John Lawson. (*Lincolnshire Pedigrees*, pp. 1062-1063).

20. **CHRISTOPHER LAWSON**, b. c. 1616, sett. Exeter, N.H., 1639; m. Elizabeth Fitton. (*Gen. Dict. of Me. and N.H.*, p. 419).

19. **PRISCILLA WENTWORTH**, bp. Waltham, 14 June 1594 (sister of Anne Wentworth No. 19 above); m. as (2) wife, at Waltham, 1 Sept. 1619 (mar. lic. 28 Aug. 1619, ae. 24), William Helme, b. 1581 (ae. 38 in 1619). (*NEHGR* vol. 127, pp. 214-215). Wm. Helme's will shows Christopher is son of 1st wife, not of Priscilla Wentworth.

19. **WILLIAM WENTWORTH**, eldest son of Christopher No. 18, bp. 8 June 1584, of Risby, co. Lincoln, named in will 1628; m. Alford, co. Lincoln, 28 Nov. 1614, Susanna (Carter) Fleming, prob. dau. of Edward Carter, and widow of Uther Fleming (bur. Alford, 22 Jan. 1613/4). (Colket, *Marbury Ancestry*, p. 25; *Wentworth Genealogy*, I 63-65; *Lincolnshire Pedigrees*, 1062-1063).

20. **ELDER WILLIAM WENTWORTH**, of Exeter, New Hampshire, 1639, bp. Alford, co. Lincoln, 15 Mar. 1615/6, d. 15 Mar. 1696/7, ordained Ruling Elder at Dover, N.H., 10 Mar. 1655/6, preached at Dover and Salmon Falls, N.H., and at South Berwick, Maine, 1665-1690, and at Exeter, N.H., 1690-1693. 5. SIR JOHN GERNON, KNT. (123-5), aged 37 in 1327 at father's death, d. 1333/4, of Lexton Hundred, East Thorpe and Great Birch; m. (1) Isabella Bygot, d. ae. 13 in 1311; m. (2) 1313, **ALICE** (28A-6), dau. of Sir Roger de Colville of Bytham, co. Lincoln, and wife Margaret de Braiose, dau. of Richard, yr. son of John de Braiose and his wife Margaret, dau. of Llewellyn ap Iorworth, Prince of Wales. Alice was wid. of Guy Gobaud by 14 Apr. 1313. Sir John m. (3) Margaret, dau. of Sir John Wigton. *The Gen.* vol. 8-9, pp. 127-131, shows that Sir John Gernon, No. 5, did not have a dau. named Margaret. Line breaks at this point.

5. SIR WILLIAM la ZOUCHE (74-5), b. 18 or 21 Dec. 1276, d. 11 or 12 Mar. 1351/2; m. bef. 15 Feb. 1295/6, Maud, dau. of John Lovel, Lord Lovel. (*CP XII* (2), 938 *et seq.* for all refs. gens. 5-13).
