1 **DANIEL**, appar. Scarb., had m. Mary Moore by July 1676.

2 **HUGH**, in N. H. Ct. in 1669 for assaulting Martin Hall to the extent that his cure cost 50s. Jane Walford went his bonds. Scarb. 1681. Lists 238a, 226.

3 **JOHN**, Scarb., in 1674 sent to Boston with Amy, w. of Richard Willing, to be tried for adultery, at that time a capital offence; acquitted 3 Mar. 1673-4.

4 **PETER**, tailor, first appear. Dover tax list 1663, yet the same yr. 'of Isles of Shoals' and bot there. Constable 1666. Fined in Maine court for forcibly evicting Wm. Pitts, but sustained in jailing him. 1666 appraiser on Rev. Joseph Hull's estate. Next yr. bot 2 a. near Portsm. meeting ho. where he appar. liv. until going to Salem to live with his son. In 1670 he sold his ho. at the Shoals. Gr. J. 1670, 1672. In 1670 he took deed from Wm. Palmer of 12 a. in Kit. to bring up his dau. from 4 to 20, added to it by two other deeds in 1674 and 1682, and sold the whole in 1685. In 1684 was fined for expr. his opin. of Cranfield. O.
