Deed dated 13 Mar 1830, James Nutter Jr. and wife Hannah sold what appears to be two acres of land in Newington to Aaron Hodgdon for \$100.57 (seems a strange amount). The land was bounded on the north by the highway leading from Portsmouth to Greenland, on the south by the land owned by Abraham Pickering, and on the east by land owned by (unreadable) Nathaniel A. Haven. There was also a "dwelling" on the land that was included.

The description of this land makes it clear that it abuts the land mentioned in the above older deed and mentioned James Nutter Jr. as an owner of the abutting land.
